IOW NQT APPROPRIATE BODY

2019-20

The Island Teaching Alliance will once again be working alongside Portswood Teaching School Alliance in 2019-20 to provide an independent Appropriate Body service for the NQT year.

As part of this service, we will provide an NQT handbook, with training for mentors and ongoing advice and guidance on the NQT induction year. We will make you aware of any changes to regulations and support you with any concerns over the progress of any of your NQTs.

The experienced team will take responsibility for receiving and registering assessment forms and will quality assure these against the Teachers' Standards. We will diligently take decisions on the outcome of statutory inductions for NQTs. We will not passively file away an assessment form but instead will support the school in its NQT provision.

All qualified teachers who are employed in a relevant school in England must, by law, have completed an induction period satisfactorily, subject to specified exemptions. An NQT cannot start their induction until their appropriate body has been agreed.
