Sir William Atkinson is a Head teacher, who taught on the Isle of Wight early in his career. He has been supporting education for 43 years, with 4 Headships over a period of 27 years. As well as this, he has been a Government advisor and a National judge for the Teaching Awards for the past 10 years. His work within the media is extensive, contributing to The Unteachables, and being the inspiration behind Lenny Henry's character in the TV series Hope and Glory. Sir William is recognised for taking the Phoenix High School, which was one of the most challenging schools in the UK, to the top of the Government's exam league tables for improved performance with a figure of 96%.

Phil Beadle

Phil Beadle is a British educator who has authored ten books on teaching and learning. He is the editor of the How to Teach series, and has written for the Times, The Independent on Sunday and the Telegraph. His series of columns for Education Guardian ran for nine years. As a consultant, he is an expert in literacy and behaviour management, and is a vastly experienced teacher trainer. He is a former UK teacher of the year with 20 years experience of achieving transformational results with students from challenging areas.

Sara is Deputy Leader of Rochdale Borough Council and Labour councillor representing North Middleton Ward. From 2003-2014 she was the coordinator of Rochdale's crisis intervention team, a service funded by the NHS to provide specialist sexual health information and support for young people. Sara exposed the Rochdale child sexual exploitation scandal, and the BBC recently adapted the story for the short drama series Three Girls.
